

## 15. Children are actively engaged in activities.

15a. There are opportunities for children to work together.

**Description:** Children are encouraged to work cooperatively. There is enough room to build multiple structures without interfering with others or crowding.

15b. Teaching staff provides supervision to facilitate children's activities and play, making sure all are involved.

**Description:** By making use of proximity, the teacher can model and guide appropriate interactions, and make sure all children are involved.



# 15. Children are actively engaged in activities.

15c. Free play or free choice occurs regularly throughout the day and is reflected in the daily schedule.



**Description:** The schedule reflects ample opportunities for free play and free choices (outside play and centers) throughout the morning in this classroom.



**Description:** During free choice time, this child has the opportunity to select working independently on the computer.
