



Environmental Support	Special Equipment
Materials Adaptation	Adult Support
Simplify the Activity	Peer Support
Child Preferences	Invisible Support

ENVIRONMENTAL SUPPORT

Altering the physical, social, and temporal environment to promote participation, engagement, and learning.

MATERIALS ADAPTATION

Modifying materials so that the child can participate as independently as possible. 33

ADULT SUPPORT

Having an adult intervene to support the child's participation and learning.
