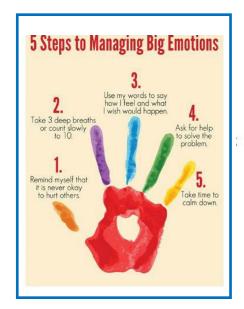


## Calming-down and Self-regulation Strategies
