2a. All furniture is in good condition.



Description: This is an example of safe, sturdy furniture in the housekeeping area.

2b. Most furniture is child-sized, and there is an adequate number of chairs/tables to allow all children to participate.



Description: Child-sized fabric furniture makes the reading center comfortable.

Description: There are plenty of seats available in the center of the room as well as nearby work centers to permit all children to sit at the same time.



2. Furnishings are appropriate for young children.

2c. Adaptive furnishings allow children with disabilities to fully participate in the program's activities (e.g., adapted standers/seating).

Description: Specialized seating allows additional support for this child so she is able to participate in circle time activities along with her peers.
