

Examples of Clearly Defined Areas in Preschool Classrooms



Areas can be defined through the use of furniture arrangement, rugs, as well as signs and labels.

Visual supports such as colored seats not only aid in making seating comfortable but can serve as cues for staying in the area of an activity.



A designated rug area for building with blocks



Corner wall, shelf, carpet piece, and pillows help to define the library area and to make it inviting and comfortable.



This area is defined by three shelves with activity space in the center. Labels and visuals on the outside of the shelves give support for activities and expectations.



Furniture and materials for dramatic play/housekeeping center define the area.
